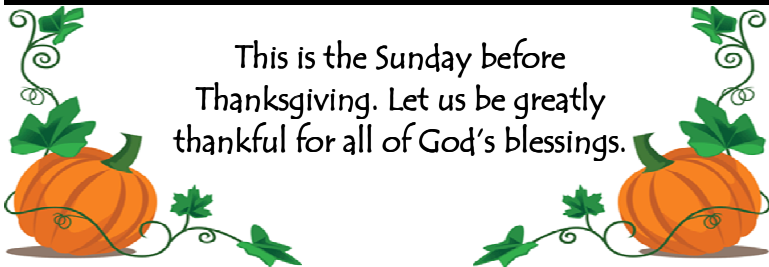

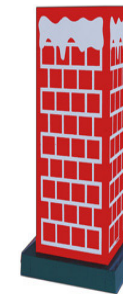
Missions Update
