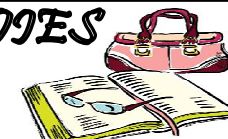
WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDIES

Francis Gibson Scholarships

Francis Gibson Scholarships applications are now available in the church office. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact Frank Huebert. The deadline is September 1, 2010

SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

This Scholarship shall be for \$1000.00 per school year.

This scholarship is available to the student(s) who meet(s) the following criteria:

1. The recipient shall be a current member, the spouse of a current member, or a recent past member of the Fairview Mennonite Brethren Church who has moved their membership to pursue education and the ability to work in a church or mission setting as part of the requirement of the curriculum or internship.
2. The recipient shall be in good standing with and demonstrate sufficient academic ability to benefit from and complete a full course of study at a higher institution of learning. Students must maintain a 2.5 GPA.
3. Scholarship is to be awarded to students who have completed at least two (2) years of college. The student's chosen course of study and career goal should lead to a degree in **ministry** or **missions** as a career. The student shall also demonstrate a need of financial assistance for achieving this goal.
4. One-half (1/2) of the scholarship monies will be awarded for the first semester. The scholarship will be evaluated at the end of the semester to determine the student's progress and continuation of said scholarship. A copy (hard or e-mailed) of the transcript from the institution of education will be required showing the student has carried at least twelve (12) hours and has maintained a GPA of at least 2.5.
5. Scholarship applications are to be submitted to the Scholarship Fund Trustees by September 1 for approval.

6. All scholarships will be paid directly to the student's account at the institution for school-related expenses including tuition, room and board, or books including off campus housing expense.
7. Preference will be given but not restricted to M.B. related schools (Tabor College, Fresno Pacific University and the Mennonite Brethren Biblical Seminary)
