Beth Moore Simulcast

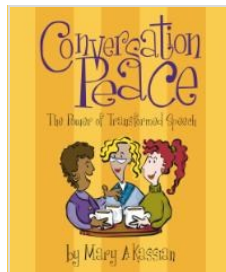
